The Community Jazz Center of Greater Des Moines (CJC) will be awarding two \$500.00 scholarships in October 2023 — The Vic Anderson Scholarship and the Stu & Nadine Calhoon Scholarship. We encourage all middle school to high school jazz students to submit your application for these scholarships. The deadline for the application/essay is September 11, 2023, and the winners will be announced as part of CJC's annual Jazz Hall of Fame event in late October.

SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS:

Students applying for these scholarships must meet the following qualifications:

- Be enrolled in middle school of high school in a 60-mile radius of Des Moines, IA (at the time of the application due date).
- Must have attended a minimum of two CJC First Sunday of the Month Jam Sessions*
- · Submit the application form and essay (details below).
- Use the funds received for jazz education or musical equipment (lowa institutions, teachers and retailers preferred.)
