Phil Mattson created the curriculum for the School for Music Vocations at Southwestern Community College, and directed the Concert Choir, Chamber Singers, and Voices Iowa in addition to his classroom teaching duties. Prior to coming to Iowa, Phil taught at California and Washington. During his career, Phil published more than 70 choral and vocal jazz arrangements and compositions and produced three CDs and an instructional video with Voices Iowa.

Phil was also active conductor, pianist, arranger and clinician and writer for professional vocal groups including the Four Freshmen and Manhattan Transfer. Phil died in 2019 at the age of 80.
