Scott Smith's first appearance was at Hoyt Sherman Place when he was two-years-old and he hasn't stopped performing since! He was involved with both vocal and instrumental groups throughout his school years. Scott launched his professional career in 1959 on Rush Street in Chicago. He eventually made his way to the West Coast where he performed with George Burns, Jack Benny and Jerry Lewis.

After ten years of the Vegas, Reno and Tahoe circuit, Scott returned to Des Moines where he quickly became a sought-after pianist/singer at the city's most popular night spots. In 1980, Scott left Des Moines for the casinos of Atlantic City, returning five years later to reclaim his position as one of the area's most sought-after entertainers.
